Maths

This term our main focus will be: extending our recognition of numbers, recording numbers using correct formation, ordering numbers and problem solving. We will be counting, and using manipulatives, number lines and 100 squares to support this. In addition we will be learning about 2D shapes, positional language and language related to time.

Reading Books

Reading books will be sent home on Monday, Wednesday and Fridays. Discussing and re-reading the texts are a great way to develop your child's comprehension and fluency when reading.

Our Topic Magical Me

This half term we will be focussing on the topic 'Magical Me'. Within this unit we will explore the children's interests, families and unique qualities that make them special, as well as how to look after ourselves and our bodies.

We will be encouraging the children to share their feelings, opinions, interests and ideas. You can support your child further by discussing:

- How they are feeling
- Different parts of their body
- Their favourite food/toy

You will receive a fortnightly letter detailing the sounds and tricky words your child has been learning in phonics lessons and useful tips on how to support them at home.
