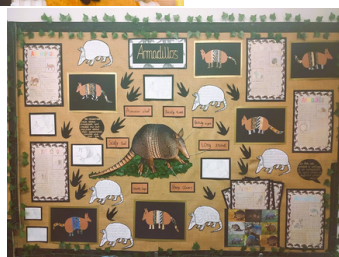
It has been another busy week and the children have been enjoying what might be the last throes of autumn sunshine at play and lunch times! Please make sure that children have raincoats at the ready for next week!

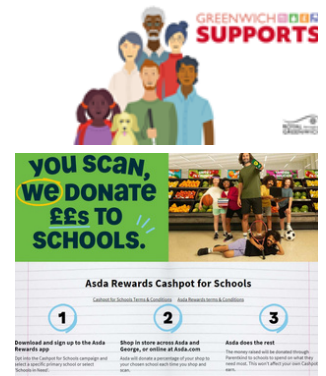
