NSPCC Number Day

Next Friday is NSPCC Number Day - Children are invited to come to school wearing their own clothes with a number theme. We ask that children bring in a voluntary £1.00 donation for the NSPCC. On this day we will be launching Coin Quest as an additional charity fundraiser. Every year group will have a Coin Quest jar which will be on the playground every morning beginning on Friday 7th February until the following Thursday (13th). 1p and 2p coins should be placed in their own year group jar as these have a +ve value. Silver coins have a -ve value and should therefore be placed in another year group's jar. Silver coins act as saboteurs as their value will be taken away from the year group's jar that they are placed in. We will explain the rules to the children on Thursday next week and all you have to do is bring any spare change into school for your child to place in the Coin Quest jars (remember - copper in their own and silver in others!) ALL money collected will be going to the NSPCC charity.
