Supporting Sherington – New Ways to Give

- **Workplace giving via CAF** – a simple, tax-efficient way to give regularly through your salary
- **Benevity** – used by many large employers for donations, which they often match

To get started, simply search for “Friends of Sherington” in your workplace giving platform (e.g. Benevity or CAF). These are all fantastic ways to support Sherington — helping to upgrade the school's ICT facilities and support a range of smaller projects that enrich day-to-day school life.
